Recent studies of coffee & caffeine suggest potential health risks. The National Public Health Institute in Helsinki, Finland showed the number of cups of coffee consumed daily was directly proportional to the prevalence of positivity for rheumatoid factor. The University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center found arterial BP increased with oral caffeine in men with hypertension and those at risk of hypertension.
